The Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India conducts an Epidemic Intelligence Services (EIS) Programme at National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), Delhi. The programme is implemented in technical collaboration of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), USA.

This two years training programme is designed to train public health professionals with skills in epidemiology necessary for public health action including surveillance, effective and rapid response to any public health event or crisis. Now, the EIS training Programme is also linked to a Master's in Applied Epidemiology (MAE) degree in collaboration with the H.N.B. Medical Education University, Uttarakhand.

Regular employees of Central/State Health Service or equivalent (local bodies) with MBBS Degree and/or MD (Public Health/ Preventive and Social Medicine/ Community Medicine) and/or MD (Clinical or Para-Clinical) and/or Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical and Para-clinical and/or BDS/BVSc field with relevant experience and age not exceeding 45 years are eligible to apply to this training programme.

We would like to request you to kindly nominate eligible officers from your organization for a period of two years for the MAE-India EIS Programme tentatively scheduled to start from October, 2024.
